2020 Women's City Golf Tournament Rules

<p>1. All play will be conducted under the USGA and R&A Rules of Golf and applicable local rules under the direction of the tournament committee. The ball will be played down both days of the tournament. Please Note: Rule 3 of the Rules of Golf regarding Rules of Amateur Status states “An amateur golfer must not play golf for prize money or its equivalent in a match, competition or exhibition.” The amount makes no difference.</p> <p>2. Slow play will not be tolerated. Players are expected to play in 4 1/2 hours or less. Keep position with the group in front. Penalty for breach: 1st offense, warning; 2nd offense, one-stroke penalty; 3rd offense, two-stroke penalty; additional offense, disqualification.</p> <p>3. Minimum age for players is 13. Player must be a licensed driver to drive a cart.</p> <p>4. Contestants must be permanent residents or non-resident college students of Vanderburgh, Warrick, Gibson or Posey counties or be full dues-paying members of private or public golf clubs in those four counties. A permanent resident must meet the following eligibility requirements: a. Maintain her primary residence in one of the above counties b. Be qualified to vote in local elections; file a state income tax return in one of the above counties c. (Exception for Students) A student who is claimed as a dependent on her parents’ or legal guardian’s income tax return is deemed to be a resident of the same county in which her parents or legal guardian reside. A student that is not claimed as a dependent is required to meet the above residency requirements.</p> <p>5. Contestant’s eligibility will be verified when entries are received and will be subject to review. Entries are subject to rejection at any time (including during the tournament) by the Women’s City Golf Tournament Committee.</p> <p>6. A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3. Penalty is 2 strokes for first breach.</p> <p>7. Use of cell phones on the course during the competition is prohibited except as a distance measuring device or to call a tournament official for a ruling.</p> <p>8. No riding caddies are permitted. Violation results in a 2-stroke penalty per hole to a max of four. Disqualification if not corrected when discovered.</p>	<p>9. No spectators may ride in carts.</p> <p>10. All contestants and their caddies are prohibited from possessing or consuming alcoholic beverages on the course during the contestant's round.</p> <p>11. If spikes are worn on the players' shoes, they must be soft spikes.</p> <p>12. Entry fee includes greens fees, but not cart fees.</p> <p>13. Contestants must enter an established 18-hole handicap. Players belonging to more than one club must enter their lowest current handicap index. Handicaps will be verified and used to place competitors in the appropriate flights for the tournament and will not be changed. A handicap index must be issued from a “Golf Club” which is licensed to use the USGA Handicap system. Any contestant who needs a USGA handicap may contact Monica Weiss, at 812-550-8969 or email monweis@hotmail.com. You must provide 3 scores from your course(s). Slope and rating are needed. PLAYERS WHO DO NOT LIST A HANDICAP OR PROVIDE A HANDICAP THAT CANNOT BE VERIFIED WILL BE PLACED IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP FLIGHT OF THE OPEN DIVISION.</p> <p>14. The handicap limit for all divisions is 36.</p> <p>15. Players 50 years of age or older have the option to play in either the Open Division or the Senior Division. Players 65 years of age or older have the option to play in the Open Division, the Senior Division or the Super Senior Division.</p> <p>16. In case of ties, the overall champion and the first place in each flight will be determined by a play-off starting on Hole #1. Other ties will be broken based on USGA procedure - Scorecard playoff beginning with the final 9 holes, then the final 6 holes, then the final 3 holes, and if necessary, the score on the final hole.</p> <p>17. Winners’ scores from each flight will be e-mailed to all participants and posted on Facebook.</p> <p>18. All rulings by the tournament committee will be final.</p> <p>19. The competition is closed after the prizes are awarded for the contestant's divisions.</p>

COVID-19 Considerations – Subject to change as conditions warrant

Social Distancing will be observed. Players using a cart will have the option to ride single in the cart. Each player will be offered a baggie with a sanitizing rag to use during their round. Again this year, awards will be given by division allowing for a safe number in the banquet room at any given time.

While Social Distancing will be observed, during the tournament rakes will be in the bunkers and flagsticks may be removed. Nothing will be placed in the holes to limit ball holing out.

The committee understands and appreciates that participation may be lower this year due to COVID-19 concerns. If registration is below 40 at the entry due date (July 1) the committee may determine that it is best to cancel the tournament for this year.
